As a counselor of the Hempstead Works Career Center, the COVID 19 Pandemic has made performing my normal required duties very challenging, as it has for many around the world. Before the Pandemic a typical day included arriving at work prior to the 9 am start time and preparing to assist our customers with their employment needs either by telephone or in-person. Their needs or desires spanned from job search to job readiness assistance, and often to internal or external training, whether it was to restart a career, or to increase their employment opportunities or their income, or to begin a new career path.

Fortunately during COVID 19 their needs and desires have not changed, but some are struggling with how to prepare themselves for employment due to the uncertainty of this pandemic. Therefore, many of the Center's day-to-day processes have been changed to accommodate the needs and desires of our customers, including 'how to virtually assist them in this COVID 19 shutdown and beyond while maintaining our high level of professional service and honoring the confidentiality requirements.
